A Guide for Parents/Carers and Students

How to get Reward Points

1. Keep a consistently positive Attitude to Learning (ATL).

Every half term, extra **Reward Points** will be added if your ATL score in any subject is a **3** (Good), you receive 30 points or a **4** (Outstanding), you receive 40 points.

For example, if your ATL for is a **4** in each of your subjects, which means 40 **Reward Points** for every subject. Multiply this by **6 data collections** and **8 subjects** and that equates to:

$40 \times 6 \times 8 = 1920$ **Reward Points** every year just from working hard in your lessons.

How to get Reward Points

2. Practice being a good citizen and being employable.

If your class teacher catches you doing more than the minimum, being a good citizen or demonstrating that you are especially good at one of our **8 Employability Skills** in lessons or out and about around the UTC, you will be awarded additional **Reward Points** directly onto our SIMS registers.

1 SIMS Achievement Point = 1 UTC Reward Point!

How to lose Reward Points

1. Do not be either a good citizen or employable.



If your class teacher catches you doing **less than the minimum, not being a good citizen** or demonstrating that **you are not even trying** to be good at one of our **8 Employability Skills** in lessons or out and about around the UTC, you will be deducted additional **Reward Points** using our SIMS registers.

1 SIMS Behaviour Point = -1 UTC Reward Point!

What can I spend my Reward Points on?

500 Reward Points will get you...



...with 1000 Reward Points getting you two of these vouchers, and so on. You will also be entered into a prize draw at the end of the year where you could double your vouchers!
