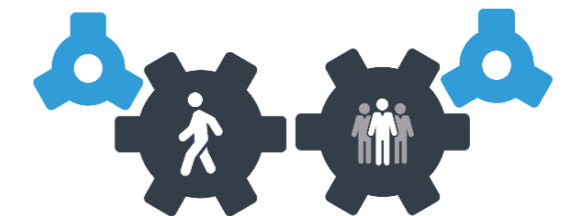

We pride ourselves on teaching students the employability skills they will need to be successful in the world of work. Students cover all of these in the first 3 weeks and they are embedded in our curriculum

Employer project

Our 6th form students have a bespoke lesson each week which is with an employer. Students work on a project with the employer in teams. These change every 12 weeks. Students must apply for the position and go through a selection programme to ensure the project is right for them. At the end of the programme students present their project back to the employers.
